If you do have to visit, and don't have a gold star, be sure to bring...

1. Proof of Identity—Birth certificate (original or certified copy) or U.S. passport (valid or expired less than 10 years).
2. Proof of Lawful Status—If you are a non-citizen.
3. Proof of Social Security #—Actual card, photocopy of card, paystub, income tax return.
4. Proof of Residency—Two different documents that show residential address. We can use the address you list on application as proof.
5. Name changes—marriage certificate(s), divorce decree(s), court order(s).
